

## **Quick Facts**

### **City of Roseburg Public Safety Center**

- The Roseburg Public Safety Center will combine Police Headquarters with Fire Station #1 and Fire Headquarters.
- Construction costs are estimated to be \$12,275,000.
- The Center will consist of 50,324 square feet, broken down as follows:
  - **Lower Floor** – 7,386 sq ft – Police evidence booking and processing; interview rooms; tactical storage; locker rooms for men and women; conference room.
  - **Ground Floor** – 17,001 sq ft – Police: Criminal Investigation; interview rooms; administrative offices for the Police Chief, Youth Services, Volunteers, Community Resources, and others; records storage. Fire: Four fire apparatus bays; air tank maintenance; shop area; logistics storage; fire conference room. General: lobby; community room; fire training room.
  - **Upper Floor** – 17,318 sq ft – Fire Administration, firefighter living quarters, Fire/Police exercise room; Information Technology offices; City's computer center; future expansion area.
  - **Storage Building** – 8,619 sq ft (police evidence storage; fire apparatus storage for reserve vehicles, parking for new Haz Mat van, etc).
- The Community Room will accommodate approximately 100 people, with a second meeting room on the upper floor for smaller meetings. The Community Room doubles as an Emergency Operations Center
- 76 new trees will be planted on the site, over 1,000 shrubs and many more perennial plants.
- 65 staff parking spaces will be provided, along with 33 spaces for police vehicles (23 covered). The parking lot will double as a fire training site.
- A storm water demonstration area will be constructed parallel to Deer Creek. It will consist of a bioswale where the storm water from the building site and parking lots will be naturally cleaned prior to entering the creek and the South Umpqua River. A path and seating area will be constructed along the bioswale.
- Construction should be complete in early Summer of 2009.
