Blasting to comply with Roseburg Municipal Code and the following applicable codes as noted

- Oregon Fire Code, 2004 Edition
- Oregon Revised Statutes 480.010 through 480.290
- Oregon Administrative Rules 837-012-1200 through 837-012-1420
- Oregon Structural Specialty Code, 1998 Edition
- Federal and Local Laws, rules and regulations
- NFPA 495, Explosives Materials Code, 2001 Edition as adopted by OAR 837-012-1340 with the following exceptions:
 1. Chapter two is not adopted.

Where blasting is done in a congested area or in close proximity to a structure, railway, or highway, or any other installation that could be affected, special precautions shall be taken to prevent damage and to minimize earth vibrations and air blast effects.

Blasting mats or other protective devices shall be used to prevent fragments from being thrown.

Persons authorized to prepare explosive charges or to conduct blasting operations shall use every reasonable precaution including, but not limited to, warning signals, flags, barricades, mats, or other equally effective means to ensure the safety of the general public and workers.

Where blasting is conducted in the vicinity of utility lines or rights-of-way, the blaster shall notify the appropriate representatives of the utilities at least 24 hours in advance of blasting, specifying the location and the intended time of such blasting. Verbal notice shall be confirmed with written notice.

Initials (Blasting Operator/Applicant)

- Applicant must have license on site during blasting.
- Use of explosives at designated site only.
- Adequate blasting mats to be used as required.
- Notification shall be made to all properties prior to each shot. Within 150' of site or 300' if shot is not covered.
- Notification shall be made to Douglas County Emergency Communications at (541) 440-4471, and City of Roseburg Planning Department at 440-1177, prior to the blast.
- Blasting conducted on property designated, as a geohazard area shall have a geotech report specific for the site, to comply with the provisions of Section 3.35.700 of the City of Roseburg Land Use Development Ordinance (LUDO).
- All blasting operations within the City shall be conducted between the hours of nine a.m. and three p.m. unless otherwise authorized by the permit.
